Policies for Economic Stability: Lessons and the Way Forward

One of the main consequences of the outbreak of the financial and euro crises has been a dramatic increase of large scale unemployment in the euro-area and almost everywhere around the world, matched by a period of tight credit markets and fiscal austerity. Even if some economies start (slowly) to recover most questions posed by these crises remain open. Was such an unfortunate timing unavoidable? How these different factors interacted? Which policies can be implemented to avoid crises becoming recessions? Can financial stability strengthened through credit market regulations? Are stabilization policies effective in a context of fiscal austerity? Can unemployment risks be shared when national labour markets differ? How can different fiscal and social policies help to minimize the negative heritage of the euro crisis?

New research is breaking ground on these and related questions and issues and to present and discuss some of it is the objective of the workshop that will be held in Galatina on 28-29 August, co-sponsored by the Horizon 2020 ADEMU Project. Authors are invited to submit papers that address the above questions and issues and, in particular, focus on one or more of the following themes:

- Unemployment Insurance
- Stabilization through Fiscal Policy
- Credit markets Regulation
